A Letter from the Board President:

On the early morning of February 1, 2023, I had the pleasure of watching seat offers go out from our enrollment management system to seven-hundred students. It was a milestone that I and the founding board had been working toward since January 2020. Back then, our ambitions were small. We *hoped* that we might successfully launch Oklahoma's first classical charter school, but we were skeptical we could.

Whether we proceeded out of sheer ignorance of naïveté is a worthy debate, but over the next several years we simply put one foot in front of the other. It was frequently exhausting, often emotionally draining, and occasionally discouraging, but we met with just enough success to keep ourselves going.

One of the major factors that helped us maintain motivation was the families we were meeting. These families were incredibly wonderful and their enthusiasm for the school powered us onward. Over time we realized that we were not building a school, we were building a community of families who were building a school. We may be the founders, but without families, we would have founded nothing.

After sending out all the offers on that cold February morning, I had the privilege of reading the celebratory Facebook updates and comments with great joy. Before that day, I had actually wondered what it might feel like. I expected I might feel proud for all that we had accomplished, but it turns out that was not the emotion that filled my heart that day. Instead, I was simply filled with gratitude–gratitude for all the wonderful families who were trusting us with their children, gratitude for board members who stuck with it, gratitude for donors who trusted us with their money despite our lack of track record, gratitude for the Poarch family who took a chance on us and *moved* to Oklahoma, gratitude for the recently hired employees who joined a tiny little start-up in a cramped and hot office, gratitude for every parent who hosted a parent coffee, gratitude for every volunteer who generously donated their time, and gratitude for the

community of families who built Tulsa Classical Academy.

Indeed, together we *have* built something special and it is the honor of a lifetime to have played a role. On behalf of the founding board of Tulsa Classical Academy, let me extend our sincere gratitude to you for helping us make this school a reality.
